"WE PERSUADE MEN"

2Cor 5:9-11

INTRODUCTION:

- A. Definition of persuade: (Vines) "...signifies to apply persuasion, to prevail upon or win over, to persuade, bringing about a change of mind by the influence of reason or moral considerations..."
- B. Only persuaded men change and God only persuades by the Gospel 1Cor 1:18-21. It is not a direct operation of the H.S., experience, feelings, etc
- C. Why did Paul persuade men?
 - 1. To be well pleasing to God v.9
 - 2. To prepare self and others for the judgment v.10
 - 3. Out of fear (respect) for the Lord v 11
- D. Consider with me now four questions in regard to our persuading men

DISCUSSION:

I. ABOUT WHAT DO MEN NEED TO BE PERSUADED?

- A. Their sins Jhn 16:8
 - Remember Nathan confronting of David 2Sam 12:7
 - 2. Remember the Pentecostians in Acts 2:36
 - 3. A sense of sin (guilt) is essential to repentance
 - 4. People fail to see sin as sin anymore (see article "Stuff About Things" "Plain Talk Vol 1 #4-p 8)
- B. Their Saviour
 - 1. The remedy for sin Matt 1:21
 - 2. Those who are persuaded will believe Acts 28:23
 - 3. Men must be persuaded or else Jhn 8:24
- C. Their accountability to God
 - 1. Note v 10 "all appear before judgment seat"
 - 2. Note also Rom 14:12; Acts 17:30,31

II. WHO IS TO DO THE PERSUADING OF MEN?

- A. Those that have been taught Matt 28:18-20
 - 1. The apostles persuaded men at Jesus' teaching
 - 2. Must observe all they were commanded
- B. Faithful men 2Tim 2:2
 - 1. Only persuaded people can persuade others
 - 2. Those who are persuaded of points noted in regard to "what" desire for others to be persuaded

III. HOW ARE MEN TO BE PERSUADED BY OTHER MEN

- A. With the word of God
 - 1. Note: in story of Rich man & Lazarus Lk 16:27-31
 - a. Were to hear (God's messengers) prophets
 - b. Not persuaded by miraculous occurrence
 - 2. Gospel is God's power to save Rom 1:16

- 3. "Word of reconciliation" 2Cor 5:19
 - a. Not persuaded by gimmicks, food, fun, frolic or appeal to the carnal nature
 - b. It takes the word of God to persuade
- B. Must persuade with a sense of urgency Jhn 9:4
- C. With a spirit of boldness Eph 6:20; Acts 4:19 Not apologetic, etc.
- D. With love and genuine concern Eph 4:15
- E. With longsuffering 2Tim 4:2

IV. WHEN ARE MEN TO BE PERSUADED?

- A. Now is the time! 2Cor 6:2
- B. "As we have opportunity" Gal 6:10 (literally "while we can")
- C. Most of us intend, plan and prepare while opportunities pass and sinners die
- D. Right now, today is the time to become involved in this great work of persuading men?

CONCLUSION:

- A. Have you been persuaded that you are a sinner? That you have a Saviour? and that you are accountable to Him for your sins?
- B. If you have been putting off your obedience to Jesus Christ then you have not been fully persuaded See Acts 26:28,29
- C. If at one time you were persuaded and have fallen by the wayside you need to be persuaded again to serve the Lord
- D. Remember, the Word of God is the only thing that will truly persuade men.
